Grain export statistics:

In the 2020 calendar year, accompanied by phytosanitary certificates, more than **54.3 million** tons of grain and oilseeds were exported from Ukraine, of which more than **17.9 million tons** - wheat, more than **4.8 million tons** - barley, more than **27.3 million** tons of corn.

The **main countries** to which **grain**, legumes and oilseeds **were exported** last year are:

China (18.3%),
Egypt (10.7%),
EU countries (8.5%),
Indonesia (5.7%),
Turkey (5.3%),
Iran (3.9%),
Tunisia (3.4%),
South Korea (2.9%),
Bangladesh (2.9%)
others (38.4%)



Grain export statistics:

The pandemic has made its adjustments in international trade - exports compared to the same period in **2019**, exports decreased by **8.2 million tons**. Since the beginning of **2021**, accompanied by phytosanitary certificates, **14.4 million** tons of grain and oilseeds have been exported from Ukraine, of which almost **3 million** tons are wheat, 0.3 million tons are barley, and **11 million** tons are corn.



Measures to prevent violation of phytosanitary requirements of Ukraine's partner countries in grain trade:

- Early preparation of the consignment for export
 - Control over the phytosanitary condition of grain before the formation of export batches;
 - Additional cleaning of grain at or before loading of the vehicle;
 - Making corporate decisions in the elevators to receive grain that meets the phytosanitary requirements of certain exporting countries;
 - If it is necessary to establish vacant plots or surveys in the fields
 - Effective disinfection, including fumigation, taking into account phytosanitary requirements, current legislation and technological processes.
